If you over-size your AC unit, it will be too powerful for your home. Doing this frequently throughout the day will lead to a shorter lifespan for your equipment and will increase your energy bill. Over-sized units won't condition the air in your house properly - they will "chill" the air, also known as the refrigeration effect.

Under-sizing a unit can also have its downfalls. If your A/C is undersized, it will take too long to cool your house, which means it will run for a long time and stop only briefly. This means your undersized A/C will be experiencing a high rate of wear and tear, leading to a shorter lifespan.

For those who do not have ductwork for an A/C coil to adapt to their furnace, there are other options on the market - and ones we have been installing weekly! #### There's a wealth of new building materials out there to help make your cottage totally individual, say Colin and Justin.

Oh, how the humble Canadian cottage has changed! Once the uncomplicated preserve of vacationers hell-bent on spending naïve, familial time in the great outdoors, the typical holiday respite has slowly transformed to satisfy the lifestyle (and increasingly style-literate) needs of today's design-savvy consumer.

These days, the rustic idyll upmost in people's ambition (and escaping the city a bigger consideration than ever before), the typical cottage aesthetic, across myriad destinations, has evolved *dramatically*.

The first place at which we stayed (will you forgive us if we whisper Muskoka?) was an uncomplicated pile: all rustic pine, mismatched furniture and worn, shingled roof. It was homely, sure, but we remember thinking how it *could* have been, had it been even just a little more, shall we say, 'maintained'. That's, ahem, 'diplomatic' parlance for: "tired old heap with about as much appeal as a damp dishcloth..."

But then, of course, the urban (and indeed the suburban) property market began to ramp. This vertiginous ascent triggered an increased demand for leisure homes, at which point real estate values in the rural space were positively impacted.

As the market jostled, so too did the way properties are dressed – inside, but more than ever before, across exterior planes too. Yes indeed, in the world of cottaging, the smartest abodes had a do-over!

This in mind, we've rounded up a few key 'layers' which, arranged correctly, will amplify your real estate value, whilst making your home or cottage more enjoyable in the meantime.

#### Siding

Whether horizontal cedar, vertical board and baton, metal, vinyl or even cement cladding (much of which is designed to look like wood), new siding won't only update your home, it'll leave it better equipped to deal with the vagaries of Mother Nature as her seasonal arsenal revolves. Some variants – wood and lightweight metal – can be DIY installed, but in our experience, heavier applications are best left to the pros. HardiePlank (jameshardie.ca) is a dream product that's partly cement based, but composed with real wood fibres. On the several occasions we've specified it, it's been hugely successful.

#### Stone finishes

Every good exterior should serve a perfect balance of complimentary finishes: perhaps wood and glass, painted elements and a little stone detailing to add schematic verve. While remodeling our beach-front cottage, we added real stone detailing by Erth Coverings to update a previously wood-clad chimney: its addition provides SO much texture across an essentially grey painted aesthetic. It's worth noting that

this is genuine stone, as opposed to 'composite' or 'cultured' stone. And take it from us: you see (and feel) the difference.

#### Metal roofs

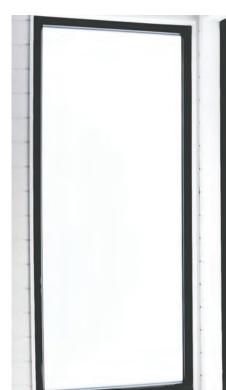
Metal roofs have become a crucial part of the renovation industry, not just in our business but across the wider construction community. Available in a host of styles (raised seam is our favourite, but you can specify wood look or metal shingles) and colours, they're a go-to across many of our projects. Pricy? A little more than regular shingles, sure, but they last much longer. Noisy? No: even when rain is pounding, sound disturbance is minimal.

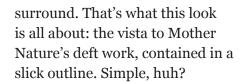
#### Decking and pergolas

Western Red Cedar is our lumber of choice: proudly Canadian, and derived from sustainably managed forests, the wood genus takes on a beautiful grey patina as time rolls forward. We tend to leave ours unfinished, negating the need for annual re-staining or varnishing.

#### Railings

Framed or unframed? Glass or metal? Or simply wood? There are benefits to each category, but our preference mixes sparkling clear glazing with jet-toned metal frames. We call it the gallery effect: imagine a piece of art framed out in a complementary, image-enhancing





#### Screen idols

Screens, once clunky and oppressive, have travelled the long road to discretion and are now much less obtrusive. Our favourites are by Sunspace whose WeatherMaster Plus system is a surefire winner. Composed of crystal-clear vinyl 'glazing' panels that slide up and down in front of a permanently positioned (almost invisible) bug baffling mesh, they're widely regarded as market leaders. Flexibility the operative word, they're the perfect solution to enclose formerly open patio spaces or to 'extend the season' in previously lesser outdoor rooms.

#### **New windows**

Installing new windows isn't just a fantastic way to update your home, it's also a sure-fire method to battle the elements, improve thermo qualities and save on fuel bills. We've worked alongside euro + glasshaus for many years, and for good reason: their products are supremely well constructed, customizable and available in a host of fashion-forward colours and styles. Just imagine how a spot of large-scale fenestration could modernize the appearance of a previously dated exterior while adding welcome light indoors.

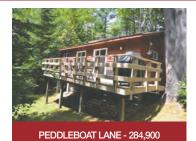

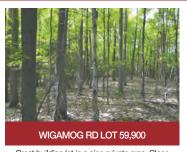

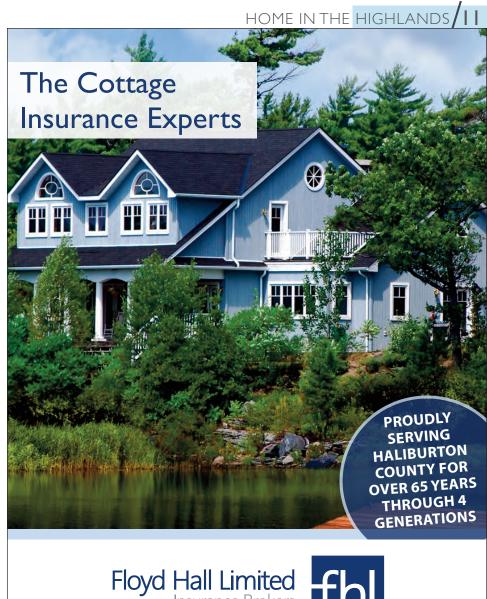

Cam Green began building tree houses when he was a kid, banging them together out of scrap wood taken from the garage or burn pile. But while for most of us it was just a passing phase, Cam has never lost his love of building homes in the branches. Now he and his partner Lauren have turned that passion into a business. Fort Treehouse Company is the couple's brainchild, a custom tree house design and build company.

If you can dream it, they can make it, up in a tree. And how better to showcase their skills than to build a tree house as proof of concept? Over the last eight months, Cam and Lauren have worked night and day to complete this super-stylish tree house, which rests in the branches of two maple trees on their property. The building is fully insulated, has a bathroom complete with shower, and electrical power courtesy of a solar panel.

design flair have pushed the project to completion in record time. Help from a host of local contractors and a financial boost from the Haliburton County Development Corporation have enabled the couple to begin marketing their dream. They are in discussions with their first potential client and hoping to confirm their first build right here in Haliburton County very soon.

Cam's pioneering spirit and Lauren's

wonderfully quirky building is classed as a bunkie. It maxes out the size limit of 370 square feet allowed in Minden Hills and tops out at 33 feet above the ground. Fort Treehouse Co owners, Lauren and Cam, wanted to showcase just what can be achieved when they really set their mind to building a luxury tree house.

A tree house, or a house in a tree? This





Lauren and Cam, 34 and 37 respectively, have lived in Haliburton County since 2007 and Minden for almost a decade but their attachment to the area and each other began years before when they were both attendees and then camp counselors at Camp Wanakita. The couple have two boys: Arlo, who is two, and little Sidney, born just days after this picture was taken. "I hope the boys will love the tree house," says Cam, "but hopefully they'll build their own, just like I did when I was a kid."

The couple formed Fort Treehouse Company in May 2019, and, with help from the local development corporation, plus assistance from many local contractors, they have built this project to promote their business and demonstrate their expertise.

This is not your average tree house and as such it isn't macgivered into the trees in some ad-hoc fashion. The tree house attachment bolts (TAB to those in the business) are a proprietary system designed and built by Oregon-based tree house guru and engineer Charles Greenwood. Minimal insertions into the tree, along with sanitization protocols almost akin to that of an operating theatre, mean the bolts that pass through the tree are super clean and the wound created while installing them heals healthily. "The tree is the most important part of our whole project and so we want to totally protect it," says Cam. "As well as 'working clean', we covered the exposed roots in wood chips and plywood to reduce ground compaction and accidental damage during the construction process."





Every kid wants to have a sleepover in their tree house, don't they? Thankfully for Lauren and Cam, when Arlo and Sid badger them to do just that they'll be able to get a good night's rest. Shrouded in natural light, the sleeping space is also wonderfully airy, thanks to a Big Ass Fan (yes, that is the supplier's name). The tree houses that Cam envisages building in the future are strictly for the 'big kids' among us and he sees them as the perfect, and extremely cool, addition to the cottage: "A place for your favourite guests to stay, or for you to escape when the family visits!"

Overlooked by the giant window, the main living space is a joy to be in. Lauren has adorned it with the best in soft furnishings and the whole space is temperature controlled by a wall-mounted HRV system (heat recovery ventilation) that removes stale air and introduces fresh heated or cooled air, depending upon the time of year. "One of our challenges was to find products and systems that were scaled down to use on a compact project like this," says Cam, "and the stove plus HRV both fit that bill perfectly." The HRV is not pictured, partially because no one will notice it when they visit, simply enjoying the forest-fresh air as they lounge on a sofa amidst the trees.





While Cam is the mastermind behind the construction of the tree house, Lauren takes over with the interior design. She has continued the warm, woody theme but ensured the space has a modern vibe. The walls are clad in Baltic birch plywood, while the floor is an environmentally friendly concoction of white sand, white clay, straw and water, produced and laid by local firm Beyond Plasters. Lauren's choice of flat black mini wood stove comes from Norwegian manufacturer, Jotul. It matches the finish on the ladder that leads to the mezzanine level, which was fabricated by Black & Smith Ironworks, from Cavan, Ontario.

Cam and Lauren are grateful to their local suppliers: Mountain Customs, MX Metals, Al Hough Plumbing, Haliburton Electric, Haliburton Solar & Wind, Haliburton Landscaping & Septics, Beyond Plasters, Wilbee Roofing, Northern Image Windows & Doors, Nortech, Cottage Country Building Supplies, Highland Electric.

If you get a kick out of home furnishings with a story to tell – items that revel in a kind of delicious ambiguity between art, design and utility – their work will raise a smile. Chris and Hendrika collected discarded skids from around Minden, then meticulously cleaned, planed and assembled them into a bed that gently yet deliberately hints at its origins. Those discolored dots are from the nails that kept the pallets together. Re-loved skids or finely-crafted furniture? You decide.

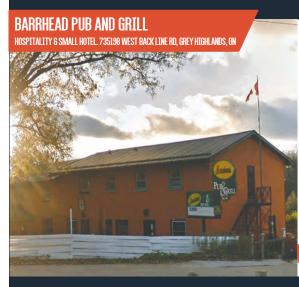

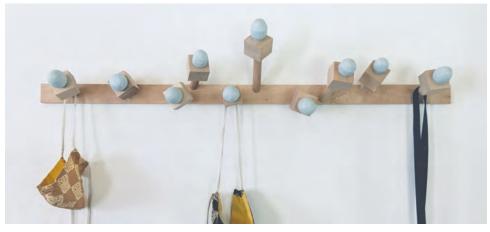

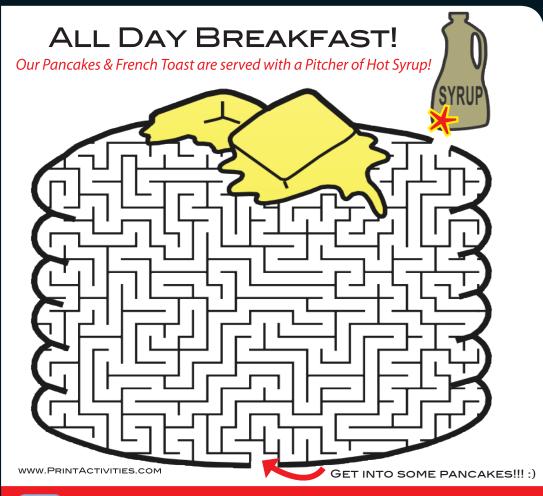

Ah, the great Canadian bunkie: all things to all people. A party room, yoga studio, office, sleeping zone or simply an extra escape in which to enjoy a good book. Here's Colin and Justin's guide to brilliant bunkies.

Whatever you want your bunkie to be, use it to improve daily life so it becomes invaluable. We've designed many bunkies in many different guises, but they've all shared one aspect in common – they've all been super comfy so we (or our guests) never feel annexed or in any way banished from the main house.

#### Identity

First things first: decide what you need, then appraise the best position for your proposed structure. Location is everything, as is function, so consider aspects your main house might be lacking and ensure your bunkie ticks all the boxes. For example, if your house doesn't get sunsets, and there's a spot on your land that does, position your building there (consents permitting) and start enthusing about your new escape. If adding beds, think about stylish ways to increase head count. Perhaps built-in bunk beds make sense? Or 'roll under' trundle beds? A little planning goes a long way: don't just pile it all in and hope for the best!

#### Three or four-season?

An increased size and sophistication quotient normally equals an increase in spend, so if you're simply looking for a lil' summer overspill, a neat one-room cabin could be perfect. If small and without a bathroom, costs will be lower – you can purchase plans from timber yards, buy a kit bunkie or get your local contactor to

build from scratch. Hey, you could even use a shipping container to create your ideal retreat. If planning more space (and a shower room) costs will grow and you'll need to consider heated water lines, extended electrical service, heating and A/C, or even putting in a new septic to accommodate the new structure.

#### Building permits and restrictions

The Ontario Building Code requires a permit for structures greater than 108 square feet, and with various codes and regs in place (often unique to each municipality), it makes sense so talk with your local township office before starting to build. Running your ideas past the planners saves both time and money and will make sure your new addition is fully legal. Things to consider include: shoreline setbacks – find out how close your bunkie is allowed to be to the water; proximity to boundaries – don't get too close to your neighbours; and rules for just how big your bunkie is permitted to be – no greater than 484 sq. ft.

#### Relationship to main building

We enjoy positioning bunkies close to the main cottage and 'joining' them visually with a deck or timber pergola detail. This keeps the building close enough to the main house so guests don't have travel too far (especially if your bunkie doesn't have a bathroom) and can also make your overall building appear bigger – great if you're reno-ing to flip.

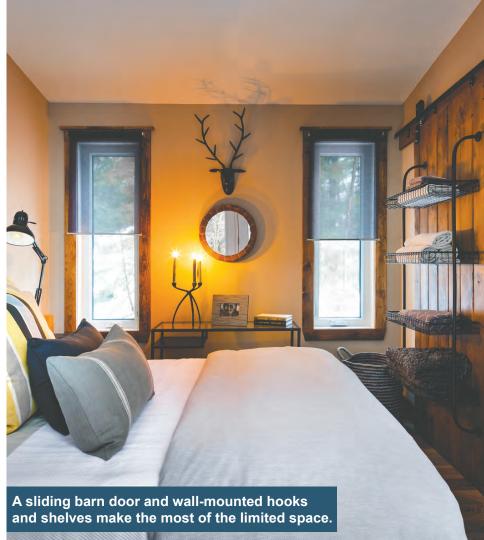
#### Bunkie style

When it comes to windows, you just can't get too large as far as we're concerned, especially if you have great views or a small space that would benefit from extra light. We've cut out entire walls, glazing them thereafter, to create connectivity with the forest. Think 'tiny house' – add wall hooks, shelves and under-bed storage (rather than wardrobes) and install sliding patio doors to take up less floor space than conventional swing doors. If you've a timber bunkie, be mindful that wood is the ultimate neutral backdrop, so don't be afraid to add colour with artwork, soft furnishings and accessories to make the space pop.

#### Comfort, comfort

When it comes to hosting guests, *little* things add up to a *big* welcome: this in mind, add lots of blankets, cushions and throws, a coffee machine and mini fridge so friends can start the day the caffeine way, and ensure your wi-fi extends so folk can surf social media to tell the world what an amazing host you are and just how awesome your bunkie is!

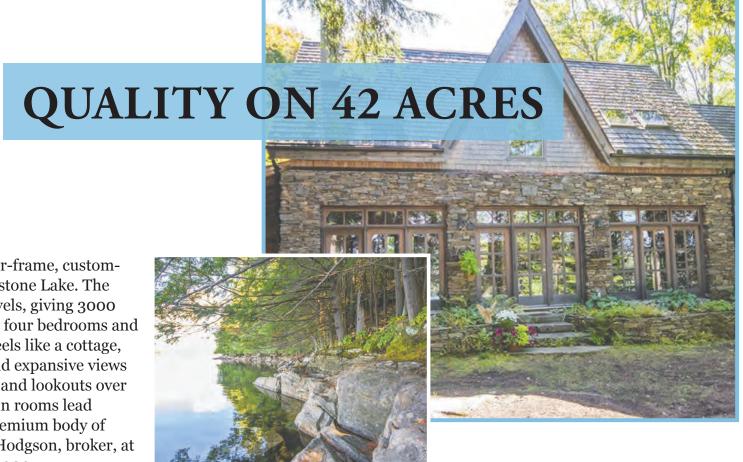

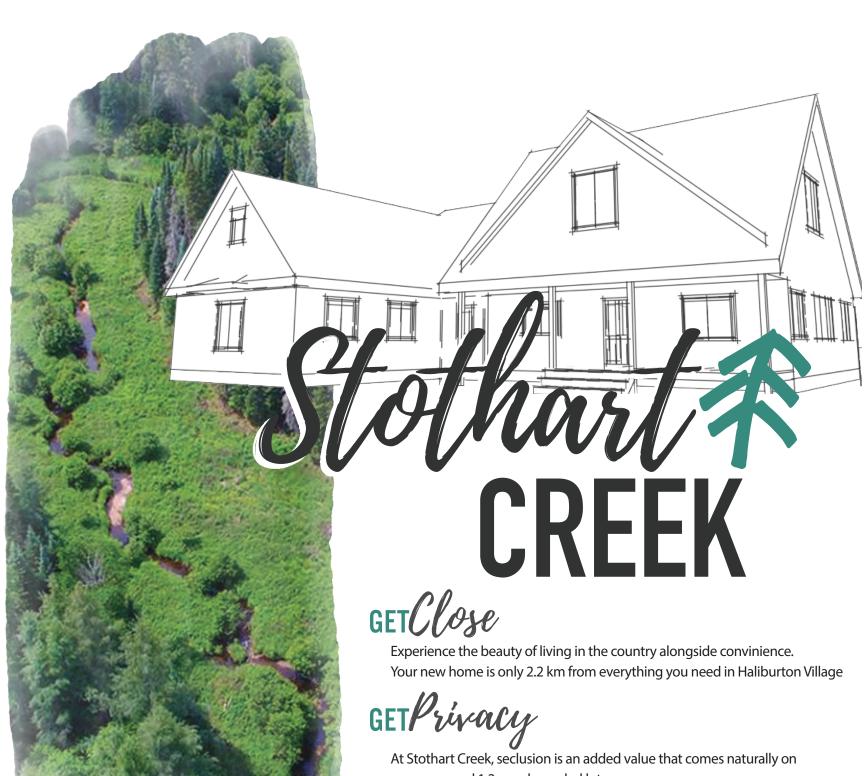
